

Dear Parent,

Due to the current global pandemic, many schools have closed or limited in-person classes for the fall semester. Younger students have been hit especially hard by these measures as virtual instruction time for some schools is nearly 50% of regular instruction. Read 2 Lead wants to help reduce the impact of school closings on young learners, so we are launching a reading program. This is a daily (weekdays) program in which students between kindergarten and 3rd grade will listen to a story and participate in an activity. The reading will take place online via zoom. Early readers (K-1) will have a session separate from emerging readers (2-3), both occurring simultaneously at 1pm.

Starting October 5, the program is completely free, but we are accepting donations to keep it running. 100% of proceeds will be donated to Read 2 Lead (R2L). Read 2 Lead is a nonprofit organization passionate about improving global literacy. Since our founding in 2016, we have opened 2 libraries in Ghana and have provided resources and programs to over 10,000 students. We hope to continue to make an impact in the communities we serve in the coming years. We hope to empower future leaders by encouraging a love of reading.
